



# AI-Augmented Course Policy (Syllabus Template)

## 1. Statement of Principle

This course operates on the principle of **Augmented Intelligence**, not automated replacement. Generative AI is a tool for exploration, drafting, and sparring, but it is **not** a source of truth or a substitute for individual critical thinking.

## 2. The "Glass Box" Requirement

All major assignments in this course must be submitted as an **Individual Integrity Packet (IIP)**. We do not grade "Black Box" outputs. If you use AI, you must show your work. A submission without a verified Reasoning Trail (prompt history and critique) will be considered incomplete.

## 3. Verification Debt & Accountability

You are 100% responsible for every word, citation, and line of code you submit. "The AI hallucinated" is not a valid defense. If you cannot explain a concept used in your submission during a "cold-check" or oral defense, you have not earned the credit for that work.

## 4. Permitted Use (The "Traffic Light" System)

- **Red:** No AI allowed (e.g., specific in-class exams, foundational memory drills).
- **Yellow:** AI allowed for brainstorming and outlining only. Final product must be human-authored.
- **Green:** AI allowed for full augmentation. Requires IIP documentation.

## 5. Ethical Citation

Using AI without documenting it through the IIP framework is considered academic dishonesty. Proper use



of AI in this course means documenting your "Learning Journey," including where you disagreed with or corrected the model.
